### **Pembrokeshire artist Sarah Jane Brown to exhibit her landscape paintings at museum art exhibition in Spain**

Contemporary Welsh artist Sarah Jane Brown has been invited to exhibit her paintings in 'Ephemeral Landscapes', a new art exhibition taking place at Museo Gustavo de Maeztu in Navarra, Spain this summer. This group show will open on Thursday 8th August and feature paintings by various international artists. Two of Sarah Jane's evocative landscape paintings 'The firefly awakens' and 'Be lost in me' have been selected for the exhibition, and will be available to view at the Museo Gustavo de Maeztu throughout August and September.

Through painting Sarah Jane explores her relationship with her immediate environment, using the landscape metaphorically to examine more emotional concerns. Sarah Jane's natural ability to convey the intensity of her experiences presents an emotional narrative throughout her work, encouraging viewers to connect and engage on a deeper level.



An Associate Member of the Guild Society of Artists (AGSA), Sarah Jane has exhibited widely across the UK and recently enjoyed several international exhibitions. Notable highlights include exhibiting with the Royal Society of Marine Artists at London's Mall Galleries and the Royal Cambrian Academy in North Wales.

Current UK exhibitions include featuring at The Russell Gallery's Mixed Summer Exhibition in Putney, London until 7th September. Upcoming UK exhibitions include the North Pembrokeshire Open Studios Trail from 24th August to 8th September. Sarah Jane will be painting daily at Etcetera Gallery in St Davids, Pembrokeshire during the Trail, and her work will feature at a special Open Studios Exhibition at The Gallery - Yr Oriel in Newport, Pembrokeshire during this time.
